### Dress Your Table for Summer

Ever had your Bamboo needles get rough?



Then you need Stix Fix. This kit will help you tune up your bamboo needles. Included is an extra fine emery cloth to "sand" the needle, beeswax to polish and a special polishing cloth. It will get rid of that little catch on the end of the needle or just give your bamboo needles more speed.

Stix Fix kits are \$10 and are in now. These are one of the great things I found at the show!

Learn the secrets of knitting Mitered Squared. Designed by our own Lisa, no seams and knit in the round, the cheery placemats will certainly help master this skill. The pattern is a combination of garter and stockinette stitch. You'll learn to join in the round, do double decreases and change colors when working in the round. Choose the colors to suit your summer table.

Materials - One skein of each of three colors of Rowan Hand Knit Cotton. Size 5 or 6 circular needles -24", 16" and double points. Tapestry needle for weaving in ends.

Materials must be purchased and pattern picked up prior to first class. Students must cast on and join into the round before the first class. (If you can't join, we'll help, but have everything cast on.) Second class will cover finishing issues.

This is an advanced-beginner class. Must know how to knit in garter and stockinette stitches, count rows/ridges, decrease stitches and bind off.

Class size limited to 6 participants.
