Included in the class are all materials, the sleepy sock pattern and a copy of our favorite "real" sock pattern - Yankee Knitter 29.



Bring with you standard knitting tackle. This is an advanced beginner class. You must have the following skills to register for this class:
Know how to work in the round on double pointed needles
Knit, Purl, Cast-On
Read a pattern.

Baby Surprise Jacket

Tuesday Evenings -
March 2, 9 and 16

6:30 - 8 p.m.

In honor of Elizabeth Zimmerman's 100th Birthday this year, join us in knitting the Baby Surprise Jacket. This class will try to teach you the zen techniques of one of the queens of knitting. This inventive baby sweater has only two seams -- from collar to cuff on each side at the shoulder. It is knit flat, in one piece. It can be striped or solid, baby or adult or anything in between.



Class includes instruction on technique and a copy of the ABC Surprise Jacket Pattern from Schoolhouse Press which gives you the pattern for everyone from infant to adult. We will make a "baby" size, using sock yarn.

Needed for class:

100 grams of sock weight yarn - your choice. Must be purchased at the shop and wound before class starts.
Size 3, 24" circular needles.

Standard knitting tackle, including markers, darning needle, etc.

This is an advanced beginner class. While the jacket is made all in garter stitch, it requires counting of rows/ridges, stitches and following a pattern.

Class is limited to 6 people.
