Learn the secrets of doing Log Cabin knitting. All in garter stitch, there are no seams -- you pick up and knit. Choose the colors to suit your summer table.

Materials - One skein of each of four colors of Mission Falls Cotton. Size 7 or 8 circular needles - 24". Tapestry needle for weaving in ends.

Materials must be purchased and pattern picked up prior to first class. Students must complete first Log Cabin block prior to class. Second class will cover border construction.

This is an advanced-beginner class. Must know how to knit in garter stitch, count rows/ridges, pick up stitches and bind off.



Class size limited to 6 participants.

Dress Your Summer Table

In addition to the Log Cabin placemat, we'll be offering workshops on a relief design with a simple lace edge, color-block intarsia and mitered rectangles. Each placemat features a different summer yarn -- Cotton Classic, NaturLin, and Hand Knit Cotton. Take one workshop or all four -- learn new skills on small projects you can use.
