Clover Hat Workshop

**Sunday, October 4
1:30 - 3:30 p.m.**

The Clover Hat is stranded crochet. To complete the hat, you will need 100 yards each of contrasting, worsted weight yarn. The hat is done with one solid and one multi-colored yarn. You also need a size J crochet hook.

Skills necessary for class: Ability to chain, single crochet and double crochet.
Skills to be learned: Stranded crochet and reading a chart.

Included in your class fee is a copy of Kathy's new book, *Crochet in Color*, which includes this pattern and many other beautiful patterns. All yarn must be wound prior to the start of the workshop.

Cost: \$30.00

This class is limited to 10 people. Paying the class fee is the only way to guarantee your spot.

Kathy will be at the store from 3:30 - 5 signing her book, talking about her
