Learn Stranded Colorwork - Nordic Headband and Hat

Sunday, November 22 2-5 p.m.



Make this lovely, stranded colorwork hat and coordinating Nordic headband. Stranded colorwork, often called fair isle, isn't hard. Learn to read a chart and make this quick hat. A great holiday gift, you won't believe how easy it is to make. One skein of each color of Cascade 220 or 220 Superwash will make both the hat and the headband.

Skills necessary: Must be able to knit in the round on circular and double pointed needles. Must be able to increase and decrease, cast on and bind off.

Supplies: Size 7 or 8 16" circular needle and corresponding double points. Markers. Two skeins of Cascade 220 in contrasting colors. Standard knitting tackle. Included in class: Instruction and pattern. Homework: Pick up pattern and follow directions to cast on and complete ribbing prior to start of class. Come to class ready to join second color.

Class size is limited to 6 people.

Toe Up on Two Circs with Anmiryam

Always wanted to know how to knit Toe Up Socks on Two Circs? Join Anmiryam for a two-part workshop. Knitters must know how to knit socks from the cuff down, either on double points or two circs. On the first day you'll learn about different types of toe up cast ons and construction and you'll cast on the toe of your choice. Spend the week working on your foot and then learn about heel and gusset construction.

Skills Necessary - Must be able to knit socks, in sock weight yarn. Supplies Needed -- Two US 3, 24" circular needles and standard knitting tackle (markers, scissors, etc.)

What will be provided -- patterns and one skein of DK weight sock yarn.
